Our outreach efforts are primarily at the pow wows. We give away Creator Speaks New Testaments, Four Directions tracts, and other Native Christian resources. We use Native worship CDs, books, and more to raise donations at these events and others. Polished Arrow takes these resources to reservations in California and additional states as well, and enjoys opportunities to work with First Youth Nations on their outreaches to youth in local and out-of-state reservations.


### POLISHED ARROW JOURNEY OF HEALING

## Equipping

We enable and equip Native Christian leaders to go where they feel God is calling them and to take along Bibles and other resources they need. Please consider joining us in this effort. Enabling them to go requires transportation, lodging, meals, and expenses. Transportation costs can include airfare but often include at least gas money and at most car rentals (Rez cars are great but not always able to go the distance). Hotel, meals, and expense money are more than many get even when invited, although there are some welcome exceptions to that. We use our funding to resource those individuals that we know are called of God but have no formal 501-C3 or giving base. We do not want to let the absence of funding from churches or other sources keep anyone from answering God's call. The vision has always been to seed resources into their ministries until such time as they are enabled with their own donor base. It has been an amazing gift to see this happen. ### Joseph & Martha Manzo



Joseph (Isleta Pueblo) and Martha (Haida, Tlingit, Inupiat, and Eskimo from Alaska) are ordained and worship with the drum. They were the lead worship team at the ANNA Call in Oklahoma, and minister on and off reservations.

### Michael Littlevoice

Mike is Ponca/Omaha and knows exactly who he is in Christ. He shares knowledge of his tribal and family history, the unfolding work and power of God in His life, speaks at churches and conferences, and shares the gospel at pow wows and other events.



### Dr. Cheryl Bear Barnettson

Cheryl is from Nadleh Whut'en First Nation in British Columbia, Canada. She received her doctorate at King's College in LA, ministers in song and is a revered speaker and teacher across Canada, the US, and internationally. She is band councillor for her Nadleh Whut'en community.



### Randy Barnettson

Randy is Sr. Pastor of Street Church which is a Foursquare church in Vancouver that feeds the homeless and operates a First Nations Bible College which trains and releases Native Americans for evangelism, pastorship, and ministry.
